DECISION ON PETITION AND ORDER

Respondent Michael G. Marinangeli ("Marinangeli") has filed a petition pursuant to 37 CFR § 10.157(b) to stay the Commissioner's final decision in the captioned case pending judicial review of that decision. The final decision ordered that Marinangeli be suspended for two years from practice before the Patent and Trademark Office ("PTO")¹ for violation of PTO Disciplinary Rule (DR) 10.23(b)(3).


Upon consideration of Marinangeli's petition stating that he intends to seek judicial review of the Commissioner's decision, it is

ORDERED that the final decision in disciplinary case D95-03 is stayed. In the event the Commissioner determines that
