Request for Remand

MEMORANDUM AND ORDER

(“Petitioner”) requests a remand of his March 2, 1999, petition for review of the February 24, 1999, decision of the Director of the Office of Enrollment and Discipline (“Director”) denying him reinstatement to practice before the Patent and Trademark Office.

Petitioner seeks the request to allow the Director to reconsider her February 24, 1999, decision in light of the documents attached to the request, and the arguments presented in the request.

Petitioner requests that the remand be granted only if the Director is able to render her decision on reconsideration within 45 days of the date of the remand order. If the Director is unable to render her decision within that time period, Petitioner requests a decision on his March 2, 1999, petition for review on the basis of the record before the Director when she rendered her February 24, 1999, decision.

Petitioner’s request for remand is granted. The request for remand, with its attached documents, will be forwarded to the Director for her review and consideration within 45 days of the date of this remand order. However, in the event Petitioner submits additional evidence to the Director, i.e., documents other than the request for remand and those documents attached to the

request for remand, then the Director may take whatever additional time she deems necessary to review and consider this additional evidence.
